He was followed by Adam Brown who completed the 10km in 44:02, followed by Chris Woodcock (44:50), Kirsty Wheeler (48:16) and Stuart Dewell (01:03:19) who felt it was a tough day out. Chris achieved a new course PB smashing his previous time by 3min and 20 seconds.



On the 20th September, Manuel set off to complete the Brutal Events Extreme double ultra triathlon or for ease, a double Ironman. The triathlon was held in Llanberris in Snowdonia. The 4.6 mile swim in 12-15 degrees water was followed by a scheduled 224 mile bike ride and a 51mile run. Due to the dangerous weather conditions on the cycle route, the cycle ride had to be abandoned after Manuel completed 58miles. This meant, his day run turned into a nightrun under very challenging wet and windy conditions in hilly snowdonia. Manuel completed the 51 mile run and completed the entire race in 29:49:42, finishing 13th out of 20 starters.
